Our Place – what's it all about?

- Our Place aims to invest £9 million across five communities: Bellsmyre, Moorpark, Newmains, Roystonhill and Greenock Town Centre and East
- To support these communities to develop projects that will address key issues and needs in their area.

Our Place Outcomes

- Local areas better identify their needs and have a shared vision for the future.
- Local organisations have increased capacity to develop and run projects which make a difference.
- Local people have services and facilities that meet their needs and matter to them.

Funding: How much is available?

- Our Place budget of at least £1 million
- £10,000 minimum grant
- £1 million maximum grant
- Eligible costs direct revenue, capital, overheads
- Grant support for up to five years

Community creates a vision for the area enabled by development support from CEiS and RCVS

Community explores ideas for potential project

Workshops and guidance given to potential projects


